Delivered by Perryfields Primary PRU in Mainstream Schools

Outreach Support for Pupils at risk of permanent exclusion:

- Helping and advising Head Teachers, Teachers and TAs. A named contact will provide face to face, telephone and e-mail support;
- Observations, strategies and recommendations for individual pupils, groups and classes;
- Delivering interventions in mainstream schools for groups of pupils in areas such as anger management, self esteem, social skills, transition, friendship, resilience and protective behaviours;
- Working with pupils on a 1:1 basis to better equip them in coping in their mainstream classroom;
- Pupil mentoring;
- Peer mediation training;
- Liaising with other agencies and professionals and attending multi agency meetings;
- Providing whole class interventions to aid class dynamics and model good practice for teachers;
- Providing whole school interventions such as helping senior leadership teams develop their behaviour policies;
- Signposting resources and agencies;
- Submitting evidence and reports for EHCP, Umbrella and Medical Assessments;
- Supporting schools with writing positive handling plans and risk assessments;
- Advising schools on PSPs, fixed term exclusions and managed moves;
- Providing recommendations to schools on bespoke timetables, classroom design and layout;
- Advising schools on the development of nurture groups and behaviour classrooms;
- Initiating THRIVE interventions;
- Helping schools with the process of writing EHCP plan applications.

Cost:

All outreach preventative work is provided free of charge to mainstream Primary, First and Middle schools.

Perryfields supports pupils on site by:

- Providing Six Week Behaviour Courses to enable pupils to get back on track and maintain their mainstream place. (Pupils attend 9 – 12.30 every day and return to their mainstream school for the afternoon). We focus on academic progress, behaviour modification and social and emotional development;
- Communicating daily progress updates to schools of how the pupil is doing on the Behaviour Course;
- Facilitating Mainstream staff visiting the pupil at Perryfields on a number of occasions during their Six Week Behaviour Course;
- Writing detailed End of Placement Reports outlining progress both academically and socially which also includes an extensive list of suggested strategies and recommendations;
- Offering CPD visits to Perryfields for mainstream staff to observe our "Outstanding" practice first hand;
- Delivering training courses to delegates in areas such as 'Managing behaviour to ensure outstanding outcomes';
- Providing THRIVE assessments and interventions;
- Supporting, advising and signposting parents.

Cost:

Six Week Behaviour Course - £750 to cover transport costs.

Staff Training Courses - £25 per delegate with discounts offered for group bookings.
