



Perryfields Primary PRU Primary Sports Grant 2015-16

Allocation £2,042.00

The 2015-16 Primary Sports Grant allocation has enabled Perryfields to purchase the use of a Worcestershire swimming pool to offer weekly swimming lessons for all Permanently Excluded pupils at Perryfields along with weekly Martial Art sessions and purchase a variety of sports equipment for team activities.

These weekly extra curricular activities have proved to be extremely positive experiences for both pupils and staff.

Impact:

Greater pupil knowledge and understanding of health education and the importance of exercise;

Improved resources enabling the children to participate in a wider range of sporting activities;

Giving children opportunities such as swimming and martial arts that they may not be able to access from home or in mainstream education;

Improved pupil recognition of safety procedures in public sporting venues;

An increasing amount of pupil participation in PE and enrichment activities;

Pupils demonstrate a greater understanding of teamwork and empathy for others across a variety of sports;

Pupil standards in PE and Health Education show significant progress since entry to Perryfields.

Sustainability:

The school has made significant investment in new equipment across the P.E. curriculum. Our Charging and Remissions Policy is not to request any voluntary contributions from parents for P.E. opportunities as Perryfields has a commitment to allocating a specific budget for this on an annual basis.
