At Perryfields Primary PRU provide high quality, inclusive teaching for all of our pupils. We ensure that we meet learning and emotional needs through excellent teaching, and by providing differentiated and personalised learning in a nurturing environment.

The Graduated Response

Perryfields uses a graduated approach, assessing pupils' needs and implementing and reviewing individual targets on a regular cycle of assess → plan → do → review . All of our pupils have Individual Education Plans which are reviewed every term.

How will I know how my child is doing?

As always, we will continue to have regular contact with you through phone calls, home-school sheets, review meetings/ phone calls, and meetings with other professionals to discuss your child's progress, and to be involved in his or her learning.

Extra support

Some of our pupils may need extra support to meet their targets. We will involve other professionals, such as our Educational Psychologist, the Complex Communication Needs Team, the Learning Team, Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language Therapy.

Education Health and Care Plans (EHCPs)

This used to be called a 'Statement of Educational Needs'

Some of our pupils may need longer term support to meet their potential. When necessary, we will apply for an EHCP under one or more of the following categories:

- Communication and interaction
- Cognition and learning
- Social, emotional and mental health
- Sensory and/or physical needs
