Who are we?

We are a team of experienced behaviour support practitioners based at Perryfields Primary PRU in Worcester.

We work with primary-aged pupils in mainstream schools in South Worcestershire.

What do we do?

We work closely with mainstream schools to support children who are struggling in school and to support and advise their school staff. We aim to help these children to cope with their difficulties and to succeed in their mainstream schools.

How do we do this?

We can:

- observe children in class and give their teachers advice on resources and strategies.
- work in school with an individual child, or small groups.
- work with a teacher and whole class.
- work with the Headteacher on whole school behaviour strategies.

Some children may benefit from coming to the PRU on a six-week Behaviour Course. We will also support them when they return to their school.

How do I access support ?

If you are concerned about your child's behaviour, please talk to his/her class teacher or the school's Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator. The school may be able to request our involvement.
