Choose a famous building from a country of your choice and make a 3D model of the building or monument. E.g. Empire State building, Taj Mahal , Sydney Opera House.	Find out about a famous explorer and where they went, what they found e.g. Captain Scott, Captain Cook, Ernest Shackleton.	On a day out, bus ride or car journey play Car Bingo.	Amazing facts about the world! Draw a picture of the world and label it with some amazing facts e.g. the biggest ocean, highest mountain, smallest country, hottest place, biggest island.
Find out how to say "Hello" in 10 different languages.	If you were going on holiday what 10 items would you take? Draw a suitcase or bag and explain what items you would pack.	Imagine you are on holiday anywhere in the World. Create a postcard and send it to Mr Hines.	How would you travel to your ideal holiday destination? Create a model or drawing of your transport of choice. Maybe build an aeroplane, train or car.
Research, draw and colour the National flags of 10 different Countries.	Take a photograph of you either listening to or dancing to traditional music from a Country of your choice. It could be didgeridoo music, Bhangra , Country and Western music, Flamenco etc...	Create a mini fact-file or information poster on a Country of your choice.	Pick 10 countries from around the World and research their capital cities.
Research the traditional dress/costume of a country of your choice. Either draw the outfit or print the information you have found.	Go to a travel agent and ask for a brochure for a country of your choice. Using the pictures and details inside make a collage to showcase what the Country or region has to offer.	Create an ancient treasure map . Can you make it look dated and old fashioned?	With adult support, create a drink, meal or dish associated with a Country of your choice.

Each half-term, we will be issuing each child with a homework grid with a selection of different homework tasks on. The tasks will link to key skills and values. As you complete each task, please date and sign the box and return the evidence to school. The evidence could be a drawing, a photo/video, some writing—a poem, letter, short story or report, a model or an object. Try to aim for 1-2 tasks per week.
